- 3) To pay a meter deposit in the amount of \$150.00, said fee being refundable in accordance with the rules of MWPWA.
- 4) In the event I or someone in my employ breaks a meter box and / or meter, agree to pay for all damages.
- 5) Grant the duly appointed representative of MWPWA the right at all reasonable hours to enter upon the premises, to tend and test meters, inspect piping and to perform other duties for the maintenance and operation of service.
- 6) Agree to notify MWPWA of my plans to move in order for the final bill to be prepared.
