THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH HAS HAS RELEASED THE 'BOIL WATER' NOTICE ISSUED ON 6/13/2022 10:25:54 AM BY ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR THE FOLLOWING AREAS. WHIT OAK MOUNTAIN EAST OF HWY 252, BARTON ROAD, POSSUM HOLLOW, BLYTHE RD. WEST END OF BARBER RD. EAST END OF ECHO ROAD. SAMD RIDGE MOUNTAIN, ALL OF DIZZY DEAN ROAD. AND LAFLER ROAD. THIS ORDER WAS ISSUED AS A PRECAUTIONARY MEASURE BECAUSE OF THE POSSIBILITY THAT CONTAMINATED WATER MAY HAVE ENTERED THE DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM AS A RESULT OF COMPLETE LOSS IN NORMAL SYSTEM PRESSURE.

BACTERIOLOGICAL SAMPLES TAKEN ON WEDNESDAY, JUNE 22, 2022 WERE FOUND TO BE 'SAFE' AND A SATISFACTORY DISINFECTANT LEVEL HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED THROUGHOUT THE DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM. THE WATER IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED 'SAFE' FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION AND THE 'BOIL WATER' NOTICE IS HEREBY LIFTED.

THE BOIL WATER ORDER WAS DUE TO WATER LINE BREAK.
