THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH HAS HAS RELEASED THE 'BOIL WATER' NOTICE ISSUED ON 12/28/2022 BY MILLTOWN-WASHBURN WATER USERS FOR THE APPROXIMATLEY 130 CUSTOMERS ON THE TOP PORTION OF RATTLESNAKE RD, CATFISH RD, VALLEY GLADE, FERGUSON VALLEY, COULTER MTN, GOFF ROAD, ALL OF ANTIOCK RD, MIDVALLEY EAST END OF BARBER RIDGE, LYLES CHAPEL,. THIS ORDER WAS ISSUED AS A PRECAUTIONARY MEASURE BECAUSE OF THE POSSIBILITY THAT CONTAMINATED WATER MAY HAVE ENTERED THE DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM AS A RESULT OF A COMPLETE LOSS IN NORMAL SYSTEM PRESSURE.

BACTERIOLOGICAL SAMPLES TAKEN ON WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 4, 2023 WERE FOUND TO BE 'SAFE' AND A SATISFACTORY DISINFECTANT LEVEL HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED THROUGHOUT THE DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM. THE WATER IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED 'SAFE' FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION AND THE 'BOIL WATER' NOTICE IS HEREBY LIFTED.

THE BOIL WATER ORDER WAS DUE TO FREEZING WEATHER RELATED PRESSURE LOSS.
